10	Beaujolais, Milhomme (Beaujolais, France) From a small, local producer, soft and juicy Gamay with the flavours of ripe summer fruits.	A	£21.95
11	Stony Bank Pinot Noir (New Zealand) Bright crimson coloured wine with aromas of fresh cherries, raspberries, nutmeg, spices and anise. The palate is restrained with sweet fruit flavours and very fine tannins.	B	£22.95
12	Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Chais du Bâtard (Rhône, France) A deep ruby colour, rich and luscious tastes from start to finish which remind the drinker of black pepper, blackberries and blackcurrants, and exquisite balance C'est vraiment superbe!	D	£33.95

18	Little Rascal Chardonnay (Australia) Flavours of mango and pear on the nose, and citrus acidity on the palate with a touch of mineral on the finish.	2	£19.95
19	El Coto Rioja Blanco (Spain) White Rioja has proved to be very much more attractive now that it is virtually 100% Viura grapes and cool-fermented in stainless steel tanks. The wine is then bottled young so as to preserve the crisp, apple flavour.	2	£19.95
